Width

The standard width of a 19-inch chassis refers to the front panel, which is 19 inches (482.6 mm) across, including the mounting ears that attach to the rack frame. The internal spacing between mounting rails is slightly narrower, around 17.75 inches, to accommodate handles or bezels while ensuring compatibility with the rack frame .

Height

Height is standardized in rack units (U), where 1U equals 1.75 inches (44.45 mm). Equipment can occupy multiple units depending on its size:

- 1U: 1.75 inches (44.45 mm)
- 2U: 3.5 inches (88.9 mm)
