- **Metallic Armored 6-Core Cable:** Features corrugated steel tape armor for protection in harsh environments, such as underground telecom or railway signaling, and uses single-mode ITU-T G.652D fibers .
- **Multimode 6-Fiber Cable:** Designed for shorter-distance applications like local networks or data centers, supporting multiple simultaneous data streams .
