Overview

Never look directly into a fiber optic cable — active or presumed inactive (verification impossible with the naked eye). Use an optical light detector (Visual Fault Locator) or a power meter, never the eye. Turn off the laser source before connecting or disconnecting a cable. Besides the usual safety issues for construction, generally covered under OSHA rules (OSHA 10 and 30), fiber optics adds concerns for eye safety, chemicals, sparks from fusion splicing, disposal of fiber shards and more.
