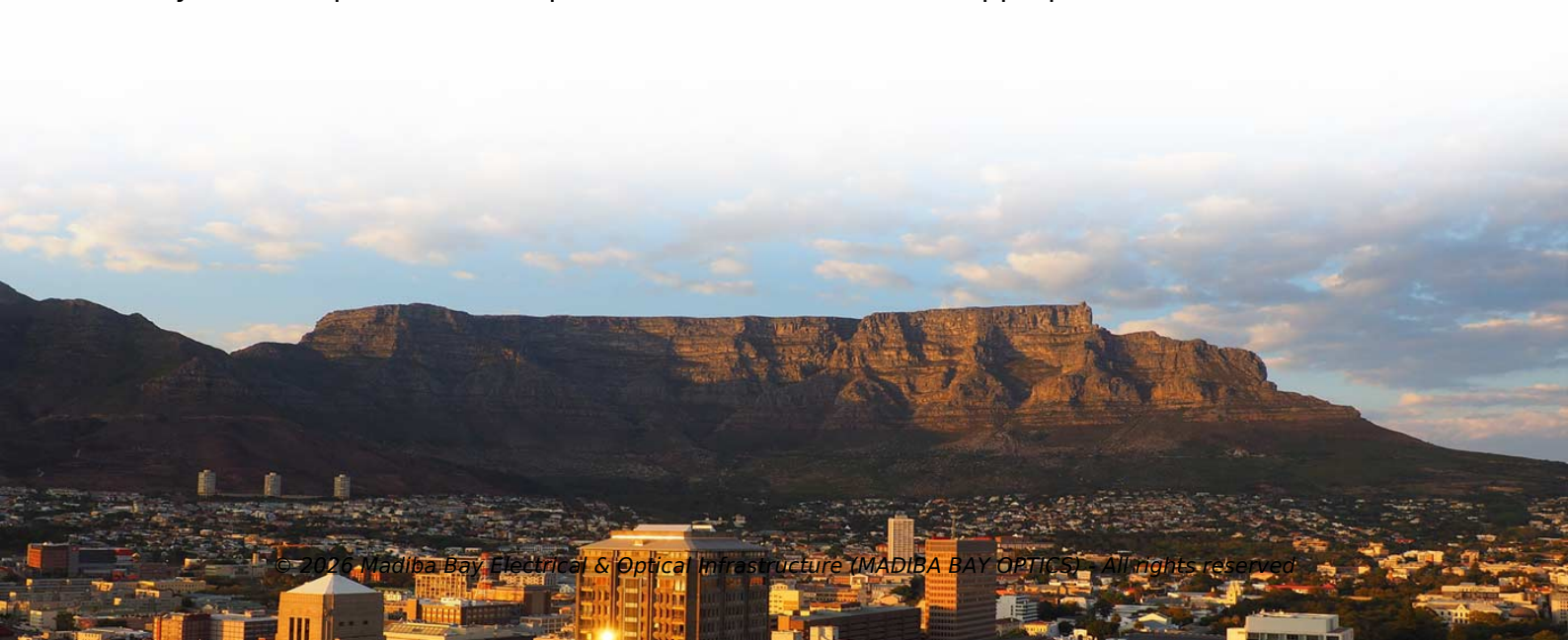


Aerial Fiber Optic Cable Relocation to Underground

Conduit installation: Fiber cable is pulled through rigid or flexible conduit (PVC, HDPE, RMC) in a trench, on cable tray, or in underground duct banks. It is the fastest deployment method in environments with established overhead utility corridors, and the only practical option for spanning rivers, ravines, and other. Deploying fiber above ground on poles or towers removes the need for underground digging and is particularly useful when the ground is uneven, rocky or both.
