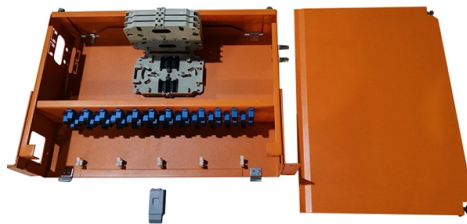

Key Protection Measures

1. Grounding and Earthing The metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and all metallic components inside the distribution box must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be securely connected through the terminal board to prevent electric shock hazards . 2. Circuit Protection Devices Each circuit should have its own protection, including:

- Circuit breakers to prevent overloads and short circuits
 - Fuses for additional overcurrent protection
 - Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or leakage protectors to interrupt dangerous leakage currents
 - Surge protectors to safeguard against voltage spikes
3. Safe Installation Practices
- Install the box in a dry, well-ventilated, and accessible location, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground .
 - Avoid humid, corrosive, or flammable environments unless using specialized explosion-proof boxes .
