

Are there any grounding requirements for the distribution box



Summary of Content

Proper grounding of a distribution box requires correctly sized ground wires, secure connections to the mounting plate and central grounding point, and a total ground resistance below 0.1 ohm.

Key Requirements

Wire Size and Connections:

- In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) ground wire is required; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is standard .
- Attach a ground wire from a threaded stud at the bottom of the distribution box to the mounting plate, then connect a second wire from the mounting plate to the factory central grounding point .
- For connections between the mounting plate and spindle plate, use a 16 mm² wire (or 6 AWG in the US) to ensure low resistance regardless of cable length or number of spindles . Resistance Requirements:

- The ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm to ensure proper fault current dissipation .
- For general distribution systems, grounding should provide a low-resistance path for fault currents, stabilize voltages, and protect both equipment and personnel .

Installation Best Practices:

- Use dedicated ground bars in the cabinet and avoid double-tapping neutrals .
