It usually functions as a core node on an Internet service provider (ISP) network. A core switch is the backbone of a large-scale network, designed to handle massive volumes of traffic with ultra-low latency and maximum reliability. Sitting at the top of the hierarchical model, core switches interconnect distribution layer switches and provide high-speed data transfer across. What is a Distribution Switch?

A distribution switch is installed and works at the distribution layer of the hierarchical network. Generally, these are used for two-tier or three-tier hierarchy networks. The real engineering challenge is keeping tail latency, drop reasons, and session setup stability under control.
