

Baseband board optical module has no fiber optic cable



Summary of Content

An optical module on a baseband board will not transmit or receive data if no fiber optic cable is connected, and proper diagnostics and safe installation are required to restore functionality.

Implications of No Fiber Connection

If the optical module (SFP, SFP+, or similar) on a baseband board has no fiber connected, the module cannot establish a link with the remote device. This results in:

- No data transmission or reception between the baseband unit (BBU) and remote radio units (RRUs) or other network nodes ().
- Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM) alarms may indicate “no signal” or “RX alarm” because the receiver detects no incoming light ().
- The system may report link down or port errors, affecting network operation.

Troubleshooting Steps

- Check the Module and Port: Ensure the optical module is properly seated in the SFP port. Misalignment can prevent connection ().
- Inspect Fiber and Connectors: Verify that the fiber optic cable is intact, clean, and free of dust. Use lint-free wipes and approved cleaning tools for LC or MPO connectors ().
