- Constructed with a tubular structure containing optical fibers, surrounded by layers of steel and aluminum for mechanical strength .
- Typically used on 500 kV, 220 kV, and 110 kV lines.
- Available in aluminum tube, aluminum skeleton, or stainless steel pipe types .
- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting Cable)
- Fully non-metallic, self-supporting optical cable .
