

Bridging a router with a fiber optic transceiver

To bridge a router with a fiber optic transceiver, you typically use either an ONU in bridge mode or a fiber media converter to connect the fiber line to your router's WAN port, ensuring ISP authentication and proper cabling.

Understanding the Setup

Fiber optic internet usually terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT/ONU), which converts light signals into electrical Ethernet signals. By default, many ONUs operate in Router Mode, handling NAT, DHCP, and Wi-Fi. To use your own router effectively, you can enable Bridge Mode on the ONU, which disables its routing functions and passes the connection directly to your router. Alternatively, a fiber media converter can bridge fiber to Ethernet, allowing your router to connect via its WAN port. Media converters are essential when connecting fiber to copper Ethernet networks, especially for long-distance or high-speed setups.

Steps to Bridge Your Router

- **Check Compatibility:** Ensure your router has a WAN port capable of handling the fiber speeds. If using an SFP/SFP+ port, verify it supports the transceiver type (single-mode or multi-mode) and speed (1G, 10G, etc.).
- **Enable Bridge Mode on ONU (if applicable):**
- **Connect a computer to the ONU via Ethernet.**
- **Access the ONU's web interface using its IP address.**
- **Navigate to Network Settings or Operation Mode and select Bridge Mode.**
