

Cable laying construction in cable trays

Planning and Tray Selection

Before installation, plan the tray route based on site layout, clearance, and load requirements. Choose the appropriate tray type—ladder trays for ventilation and easy cable entry, perforated trays for lighter loads, or solid-bottom trays for full protection—matching the tray to cable type and environmental conditions . Calculate tray width and depth according to the number and size of cables to prevent overheating or wasted space .

Support and Mounting

Proper support spacing is critical. Use trapeze hangers for ceiling suspensions or cantilever wall brackets for vertical runs, following manufacturer load charts. Typical support spans range from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and cable weight . Ensure trays are aligned, level, and securely fastened to prevent sagging and mechanical failure .

Cable Laying and Organization

Lay cables neatly using cable ties or straps, separating by voltage and function. Leave slack for thermal expansion, movement, or future adjustments. Avoid overfilling; NEC 392.22 specifies maximum fill limits (e.g., 40% for power cables, 50% for control cables) to prevent overheating . Use rollers, sheaves, and lubricants for smooth cable pulls, minimizing jacket abrasion and conductor damage .
