Cable Tray Types and Selection

Material selection depends on environmental conditions. Aluminum offers corrosion resistance, while galvanized steel provides durability in wet or industrial environments .

Installation Best Practices

- Pre-Installation Checks: Verify tray integrity, load capacity, and compliance with design specifications .
- Support and Span: Use trapeze hangers for ceiling runs or cantilever brackets for wall-mounted trays. Support spacing must match manufacturer load charts and cable weight .
