- **Bend radius:** Avoid excessive bending; follow the minimum bend radius specified by the cable manufacturer to prevent insulation damage.
- **Cable fill:** Do not exceed 40% of the tray's rated capacity to ensure proper heat dissipation and mechanical stability.
