- 3. Fiberglass (FRP/GRP) Fiberglass-reinforced plastic trays are manufactured using pultrusion with polyester or vinyl ester resin, providing high corrosion resistance and a favorable strength-to-weight ratio. They are ideal for offshore, chemical, or highly corrosive environments .
- 4. Plastic (PVC) Plastic cable trays are lightweight, cost-effective, and resistant to chemical exposure, but they lack the mechanical strength of metal trays. They are suitable for light-duty applications where heavy cables or mechanical stress are not a concern .
