

# Cable tray support arm installation spacing



## Overview

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392. Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. The rungs cannot be more than 4 feet apart. Where products of five metre lengths or above are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of three timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck. Where shorter length. Cable tray: A unit or assembly of units or sections, and associated fittings, forming a rigid structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and raceways. To determine the proper spacing. Traditionally, it has been recommended to install brackets approximately every 1 to 1. However, this guideline isn't set in stone.
