Turning (Horizontal Changes)

- **Horizontal Bends:** Standard angles such as 30°, 45°, and 90° allow the tray to navigate corners without compromising cable integrity .
- **Tees and Crosses:** These fittings enable branching of cable runs to different areas while maintaining organized routing .
