

Cable trays for upper and lower bends



Summary of Content

Cable tray bends allow smooth directional changes in cable runs, with specific fittings for upper (vertical up) and lower (vertical down) transitions.

Types of Cable Tray Bends

1. Vertical Bends

- Upper bends (vertical up): These are used when the cable tray needs to rise to a higher level. They are often referred to as vertical inside or outside bends, depending on whether the bend curves inward or outward relative to the tray run.
- Lower bends (vertical down): These allow the tray to descend to a lower level. Similar to upper bends, they can be inside or outside depending on the direction of curvature.
- Vertical bends are available in 90° or 45° angles, with adjustable options for custom angles .

2. Horizontal Bends

- Horizontal bends are used to change the tray direction along the same plane. They can also be inside or outside bends and are available in 45° or 90° angles.
- Radius bends are designed to maintain cable integrity by providing a smooth curve, reducing stress on cables .

Materials and Construction

- Cable tray bends are manufactured from aluminum, galvanized steel, stainless steel, or FRP composites, matching the main tray material for structural compatibility
