How Cables Are Positioned

Cables are placed directly within the tray, resting on the tray's support structure. The exact positioning depends on the tray type:

- Ladder-type trays: Cables are supported by the rungs, similar to a ladder, spaced at regular intervals (typically 4–12 inches). This allows air circulation around the cables, helping dissipate heat and making inspection or maintenance easier .
- Solid-bottom or trough trays: Cables rest on a continuous surface, providing maximum protection from falling debris, liquids, or electromagnetic interference. This type is preferred for sensitive or high-voltage cables .
- Ventilated trays: Cables lie on a perforated or slotted base, allowing airflow, water drainage, and dust to fall through. Small cables may exit through these openings if needed .

Organization and Safety

Cables are often grouped by type or function (power, control, or communication) and may be separated using dividers or spacers to prevent interference and maintain proper bend radius . Proper installation ensures that cables are not overcrowded, and a minimum clearance is maintained above or between trays for accessibility and future expansion .
