SFP Module Considerations

Each SFP module has a specified maximum distance, which depends on its wavelength, optical power, and sensitivity. Short-range modules (e.g., 850 nm SR) are designed for hundreds of meters, while long-range modules (e.g., 1310 nm LR or 1550 nm ER) can reach tens of kilometers. Using a module rated for shorter distances on a 1.4 km cable can result in signal attenuation, unstable connections, or complete link failure.
