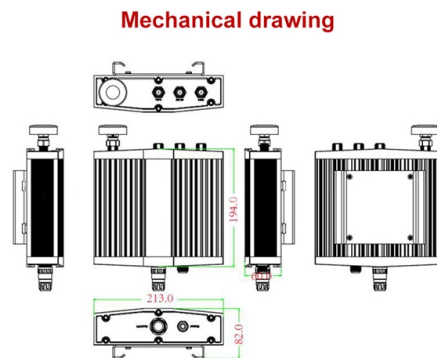


Can a partition be added next to the distribution box

A partition can only be added next to a distribution box if it does not obstruct the required working space, access, or ventilation as specified by electrical codes.

Clearance and Accessibility Requirements

When installing or modifying a distribution box, sufficient clearance must be maintained in front of and around the panel to ensure safe operation and maintenance. According to the NEC 2023 standards, the working space in front of a panelboard must be at least 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high. The panel door must be able to open fully to 90° without obstruction, and no equipment, pipes, or storage should block access . A partition placed too close could violate these requirements and create a safety hazard.

Ventilation and Safety Considerations

Distribution boxes generate heat and may house components like circuit breakers, RCDs, and surge protection devices. Proper ventilation is essential to prevent overheating. A partition should not restrict airflow or trap heat around the enclosure . Additionally, the enclosure itself must meet IP or NEMA ratings to protect against dust and moisture, and any partition should not compromise these protective measures .

Practical Implementation

If additional separation is needed, consider:

- Installing a sub-distribution board or extending the main panel instead of placing a partition directly against it .
