Overview

Overloading cable trays is a common cable tray safety hazard that can lead to tray deformation. If the weight of the cables exceeds the tray's capacity, it can cause bending, breaking, or sagging, which may compromise cable protection and safety. If the tray is not designed to support the weight of the cables or is subjected to external forces, it may deform or even break, leading to cable displacement or damage.
