A fiber optic patch cord is a short, flexible fiber cable with connectors on both ends, used to interconnect devices like switches, servers, or patch panels within a network . They come in single-mode (long-distance, narrow core) and multi-mode (short-distance, wider core) types, with common connectors such as LC, SC, or MPO . The core is made of glass or plastic, surrounded by cladding and a protective jacket, often reinforced with aramid yarn for durability .

Converting Fiber to Ethernet

Fiber optic signals cannot directly connect to copper Ethernet cables because they use light pulses instead of electrical signals. To bridge this gap, you need a fiber media converter or a network device with SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports:

- **Fiber Media Converters:** These devices accept a fiber patch cord on one side and output an RJ45 Ethernet port on the other. They support various speeds (1G, 10G) and fiber types (single-mode or multi-mode) depending on the SFP module installed .
- **Switches with SFP Ports:** Many modern switches have SFP or SFP+ slots that allow you to insert fiber modules. The switch then converts the optical signal to standard Ethernet internally, enabling connection to copper network cables.
