1. Classification by Fiber Type

Fiber optic jumpers are primarily divided into single-mode and multimode types based on the core diameter and transmission distance:

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Single-Mode Fiber (SMF): Features a small core (around 9 microns) allowing light to travel in a straight path, minimizing attenuation. Ideal for long-distance communications such as telecom networks and high-speed data backbones. Typically, single-mode jumpers are color-coded yellow with blue connectors and protective sleeves .

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Multimode Fiber (MMF): Has a larger core (50–62.5 microns) supporting multiple light paths, suitable for short-distance applications like data centers and LANs. Multimode jumpers are usually orange or gray, with beige or black connectors .
