Cable Jacket and Fiber Type Identification

Fiber optic cables are typically identified by the color of their outer jacket, which indicates the fiber type and function. According to TIA-606-B and TIA-598-C standards, common jacket colors include:

- Yellow: Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2)
- Orange: Multimode fiber (OM1/OM2)
- Aqua: Multimode fiber (OM3/OM4)
- Other colors may be used for specialty fibers or custom applications, often with printed legends for clarity .

Individual Fiber Color Coding

Inside multi-fiber cables, each fiber is color-coded to allow technicians to identify and manage individual strands. The standard 12-color sequence is:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
