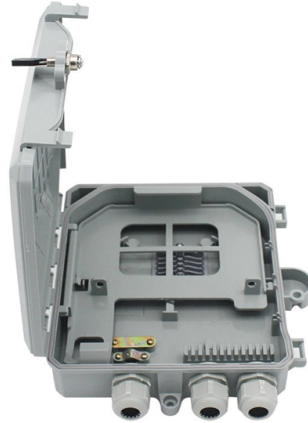


Configuration of optical modules in switches



Summary of Content

Optical modules on switches require careful installation, proper configuration, and ongoing monitoring to ensure reliable network performance.

Installation and Safety

When installing or removing optical modules such as SFP, SFP+, or QSFP-DD, handle modules by the sides or metal cage to avoid damaging delicate optical components, and always use ESD protection like a grounded wrist strap and ESD-safe mat . Avoid forcing modules into ports, as this can damage the port or the module. Ensure the module is compatible with the switch and certified by the vendor to prevent issues with connectivity or data bus errors .

Configuration on Switches

Optical modules often require configuration for parameters such as transponder/muxponder mode, DAC rate, and FEC mode. For example, Cisco 400G Digital Coherent QSFP-DD modules allow configuration of modulation schemes, shaping, and baud rates to optimize long-haul transmission . On Cisco NX-OS switches, you can also enable Versatile Diagnostics Monitoring (VDM) to track advanced parameters like signal-to-noise ratio, pre-FEC bit error rates, and laser aging, which helps in proactive maintenance and troubleshooting .
