Planning and Design

The tunnel must provide a stable and protected pathway for the fiber optic cables. Conduits, typically PVC or HDPE pipes, are installed inside the tunnel to protect the cables from mechanical stress, moisture, and future excavation . In high-traffic or urban areas, horizontal directional drilling (HDD) or narrow trenching may be used to minimize surface disruption . Conduits should include pulling tapes or innerducts to facilitate cable installation and allow for future upgrades .
