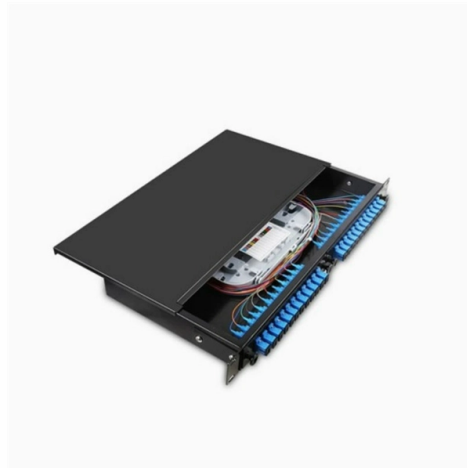

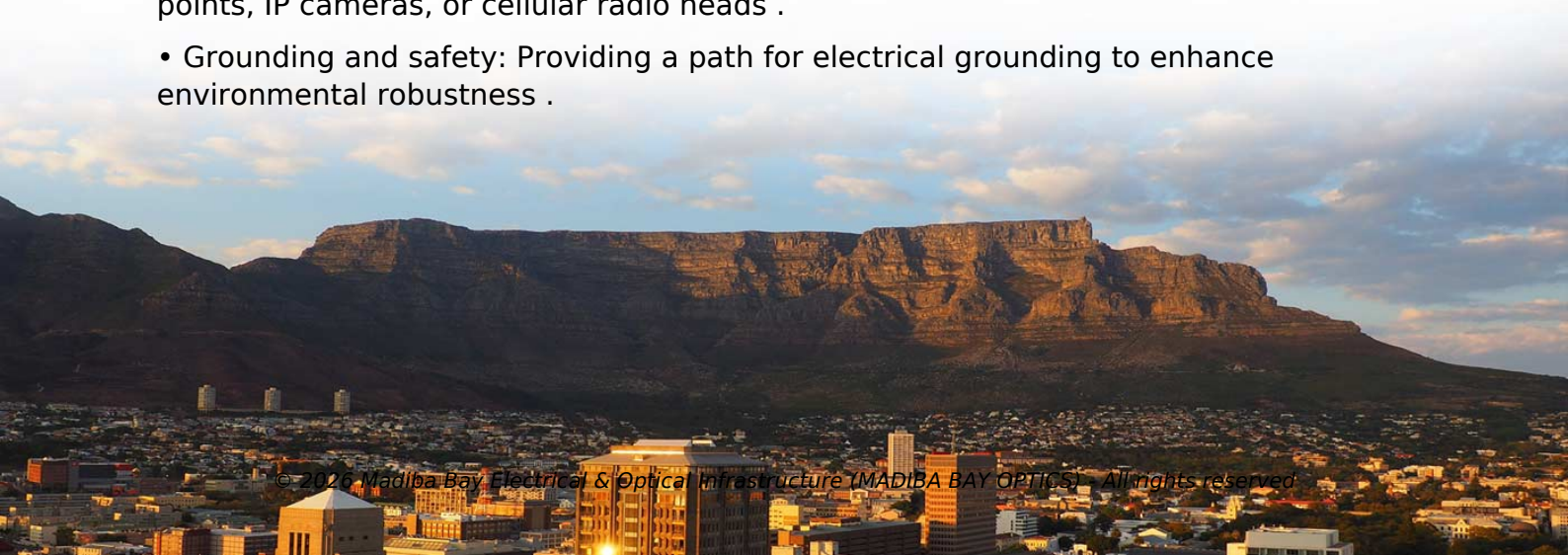
Pure Fiber Optic Cables

Pure fiber optic cables are composed of ultra-pure glass or plastic fibers that transmit data using light pulses rather than electrical signals. The main components include a core for light transmission, a cladding layer to reflect light back into the core, a buffer coating for protection, and an outer jacket for environmental durability. These cables do not contain metallic copper, which allows them to be immune to electromagnetic interference, electrically isolated, and capable of extremely high bandwidth over long distances.

Hybrid Fiber-Copper Cables

Some fiber optic cables integrate copper conductors alongside the optical fibers. These hybrid designs are used when electrical power or grounding is needed in addition to data transmission. Copper in these cables can serve several purposes:

- Power delivery: Supplying DC power to remote devices such as wireless access points, IP cameras, or cellular radio heads.
- Grounding and safety: Providing a path for electrical grounding to enhance environmental robustness.
