Core Switches

A core switch is positioned at the backbone of a network, typically at the top of a three-layer hierarchical architecture consisting of core, distribution, and access layers . Its primary responsibilities include:

- High-speed data routing and switching: Core switches handle large volumes of traffic between distribution and access layers, ensuring minimal latency and high throughput .
- Gateway functionality: They often act as the gateway to wide area networks (WANs) or the Internet, aggregating traffic from multiple distribution switches .
- Redundancy and reliability: Core switches support features like link aggregation, VRRP, HSRP, and hot standby to maintain network stability in case of hardware failure .
- Advanced management: Layer 3 core switches provide VLAN support, Quality of Service (QoS), and security features such as ACLs and VPN capabilities . Key performance parameters include forwarding rate, which measures the number of packets the switch can process per second, and backplane bandwidth, which ensures the switch can handle peak traffic loads without bottlenecks .
