

Correct placement method for optical cables



Summary of Content

Optical cables should be installed using careful pulling or blowing techniques, maintaining proper bend radius, avoiding twists, and protecting the cable from mechanical and environmental damage.

Pre-Installation Planning

Before installation, conduct a thorough site survey to identify obstacles, high-temperature areas, or machinery that could damage the cable. Develop a cable pulling plan detailing reel locations, intermediate access points, splice locations, and responsibilities of the installation team. Ensure compliance with local building codes and keep fiber optic cables away from power lines if metallic components are present .

Handling and Preparation

- Keep protective material on the cable until installation to prevent damage .
- Cover cable ends with end caps or heavy tape to prevent moisture ingress .
- Avoid pulling on connectors; use a proper pulling grip with a swivel to prevent twisting .
- Maintain cable temperature within the manufacturer's specified range, especially for LSZH sheathed cables .
