

# Curvature during the laying of optical cables in ducts



## Summary of Content

The curvature of optical cables in ducts must respect the minimum bend radius to prevent macrobending losses and mechanical damage, typically defined as a multiple of the cable diameter.

### Minimum Bend Radius

Optical cables are sensitive to bending, and excessive curvature can cause macrobending, which increases optical loss. The minimum bend radius is usually specified in the cable datasheet and depends on whether the cable is under tension during installation or already installed. For example, Corning recommends a working bend radius of 15 times the cable outer diameter during installation and a smaller radius after installation, depending on the cable type and construction (e.g., loose tube or ribbon) .

### Macrobending Effects

Macrobending occurs when the fiber is bent with a radius that is too small, causing light to escape from the core and increasing attenuation. ITU-T G.657 fibers are optimized for reduced macrobending loss, but even these fibers have limits. The optical loss increases as the bending radius decreases, so careful planning of duct routes and bends is essential .
