Importance of Wire Diameter

The diameter of a wire determines its current-carrying capacity (ampacity). Using a wire that is too thin for a circuit can cause excessive heating, insulation damage, and potential fire hazards, while an oversized wire may be unnecessarily costly and difficult to handle. Distribution boxes, whether residential, commercial, or industrial, require careful selection of wire sizes to match the load of each circuit and the rating of the connected breakers or fuses ().

Common Wire Sizes and Applications

- #14 AWG copper wire: Typically used for 15-amp circuits, such as lighting and small outlets. Diameter is approximately 1.63-1.84 mm ().
- #12 AWG copper wire: Used for 20-amp circuits, including kitchen outlets and small appliances. Diameter is about 2.05 mm ().
- #10 AWG copper wire: Suitable for 30-amp circuits, such as water heaters or air conditioning units. Diameter is roughly 2.59 mm ().
- #8 AWG copper wire: Often used for 40-50 amp circuits, including larger appliances or subpanels. Diameter is approximately 3.26 mm ().
