

Dimensions of Iron Cable Trays



Summary of Content

Iron cable trays are available in standardized widths from 50 mm to 1000 mm, heights from 25 mm to 150 mm, and lengths typically around 3 meters, with material thickness varying by load requirements.

Standard Widths

Cable tray width is the primary factor determining cable capacity. Standard inside widths for iron trays typically range from 50 mm to 1000 mm (or 6 inches to 36 inches) depending on the application . Narrow trays (100-150 mm) are used for instrumentation and control wiring, medium trays (300-600 mm) for general power distribution, and wide trays (>600 mm) for heavy industrial installations, data centers, or large power cable runs .

Tray Heights (Depths)

The height, often called side rail height or tray depth, controls vertical stacking capacity and heat dissipation. Standard heights range from 25 mm to 150 mm, with deeper trays allowing more cable layers and better airflow for heat management . Ladder trays, in particular, benefit from higher side rails for heavy cable loads and long support spans .

Tray Lengths

Cable trays are manufactured in straight sections for ease of transport and installation. Typical standard lengths are around 3 meters (10 feet), though shorter or longer sections may be available depending on manufacturer and project requirements . Splice plates and support locations are used to maintain structural integrity over long runs .
