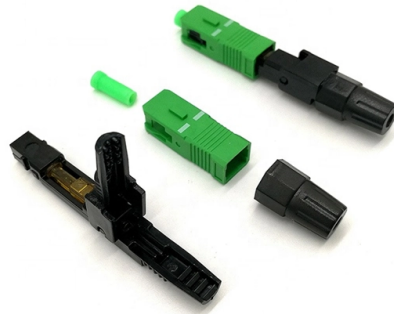

Color Coding and Identification

In accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC), equipment grounding conductors can be bare, covered, or insulated. When insulated, they must be green or green with one or more yellow stripes to clearly indicate their function as ground wires, except in certain low-voltage or power-limited circuits where other uses are allowed . This ensures that grounding conductors are easily distinguishable from live or neutral wires.

Terminal Markings

Inside distribution boxes or junction blocks, the ground terminals are often marked with the standard grounding symbol □. This symbol indicates the Protective Earth (PE) connection point, allowing assembly and maintenance personnel to quickly locate the grounding terminal . These terminals are usually positioned near DIN rails or mounting plates for convenient connection to the overall grounding system.

International Standards

The IEC 60446 standard provides global guidelines for identifying electrical conductors and terminals. It mandates consistent use of color codes, symbols, and labeling methods to prevent miswiring and enhance safety. Ground terminals and wires must be clearly marked to ensure proper connection and compliance with international safety regulations .
