

Distribution box directly connected to the mains



Summary of Content

A distribution box receives power directly from the mains through a main breaker, distributing electricity safely to individual circuits while providing protection via MCBs, RCCBs, and proper grounding.

Main Connection

The distribution box, also called a distribution board or breaker box, is the central hub where the incoming mains supply (phase/live and neutral) enters the building . The live wire (L) is connected to the line terminal of the main MCB, which acts as the main switch controlling the entire electrical supply . The neutral wire (N) is connected to the neutral busbar, which distributes neutral to all branch circuits . The protective earth (PE) wire is connected to the earth busbar, ensuring safety against earth faults .

Circuit Protection

The main MCB (usually a double-pole MCB in single-phase systems) protects the entire distribution box from overcurrent and short circuits . From the main MCB, power is routed to RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) for protection against leakage currents and electric shocks . Individual circuits are then connected via single-pole or double-pole MCBs, depending on the load requirements . Each MCB controls a specific circuit, such as lighting, outlets, or appliances, and trips automatically in case of overload.
