A distribution box is connected to an electricity meter to safely distribute power from the utility supply to various circuits in a building, using protective devices like circuit breakers, busbars, and proper grounding.

Overview of the Connection

The electricity meter serves as the entry point for power from the utility company, measuring consumption. From the meter, the incoming live (phase) and neutral wires are routed to the main circuit breaker in the distribution box, which acts as the primary protective device for the entire electrical system. The distribution box, also called a panel board or consumer unit, contains:

- Main Circuit Breaker (MCB or RCD): Protects the entire system from overloads and short circuits.
- Branch Circuit Breakers: Protect individual sub-circuits such as lighting, sockets, or appliances.
- Busbars: Common connection points for live, neutral, and earth wires.
- Earth/Grounding Link: Ensures safety by connecting all metallic parts to the earth electrode.

Wiring Steps

- Turn off the main power supply before starting any work to ensure safety.
- Connect the meter terminals: The live and neutral wires from the utility meter are connected to the input terminals of the main circuit breaker in the distribution box.
