

Do cable trays need to be installed in cable wells



Summary of Content

Cable trays in cable wells are installed by planning the route, selecting the appropriate tray type, mounting supports, securing the trays, and properly laying and fastening cables according to standards.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, review approved shop drawings to determine the tray layout, length, and location within the cable well, ensuring proper clearance and load capacity for the cables to be supported . Inspect all materials for damage and verify that they meet project specifications. Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports to prevent deformation or moisture damage .

Selecting Tray Type and Size

Choose the appropriate tray type based on cable type, load, and environmental conditions. Common types include ladder trays for large power cables, ventilated troughs for smaller control cables, and solid-bottom trays for protection against dust or electromagnetic interference . Calculate tray width and depth according to the number and size of cables to prevent overcrowding and overheating .
