However, when optical fiber cable contains metallic components such as steel armor or strength members, it is necessary to ground and bond the fiber optic cable to reduce radiated and conducted electromagnetic emissions, as well as to dissipate electrostatic charges that would otherwise build-up on. While nonarmored fiber optic cables don't require grounding due to their nonconductive properties, grounding is crucial when using armored fiber optic cables. These cables include metallic components that can carry electrical currents, presenting potential hazards such as electrical shock or fire. Optical fiber cables entering the building or terminating on the outside of the building shall comply with 770. The critical distinction lies in.
