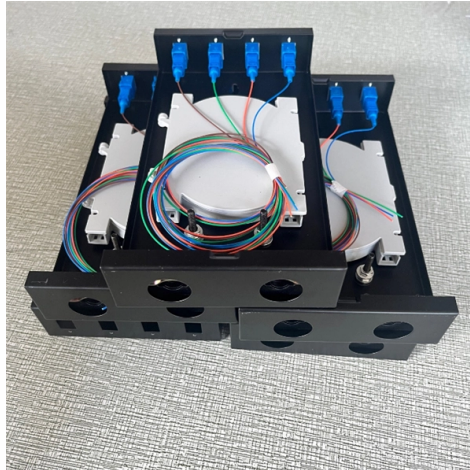

Carrier-Grade Routers for OSPF

Carrier-grade routers are designed for high-performance, reliable routing in large enterprise or ISP networks. Popular models include:

OSPF routers exchange Link State Advertisements (LSAs) to maintain a consistent network map and calculate shortest paths using the SPF/Dijkstra algorithm .
