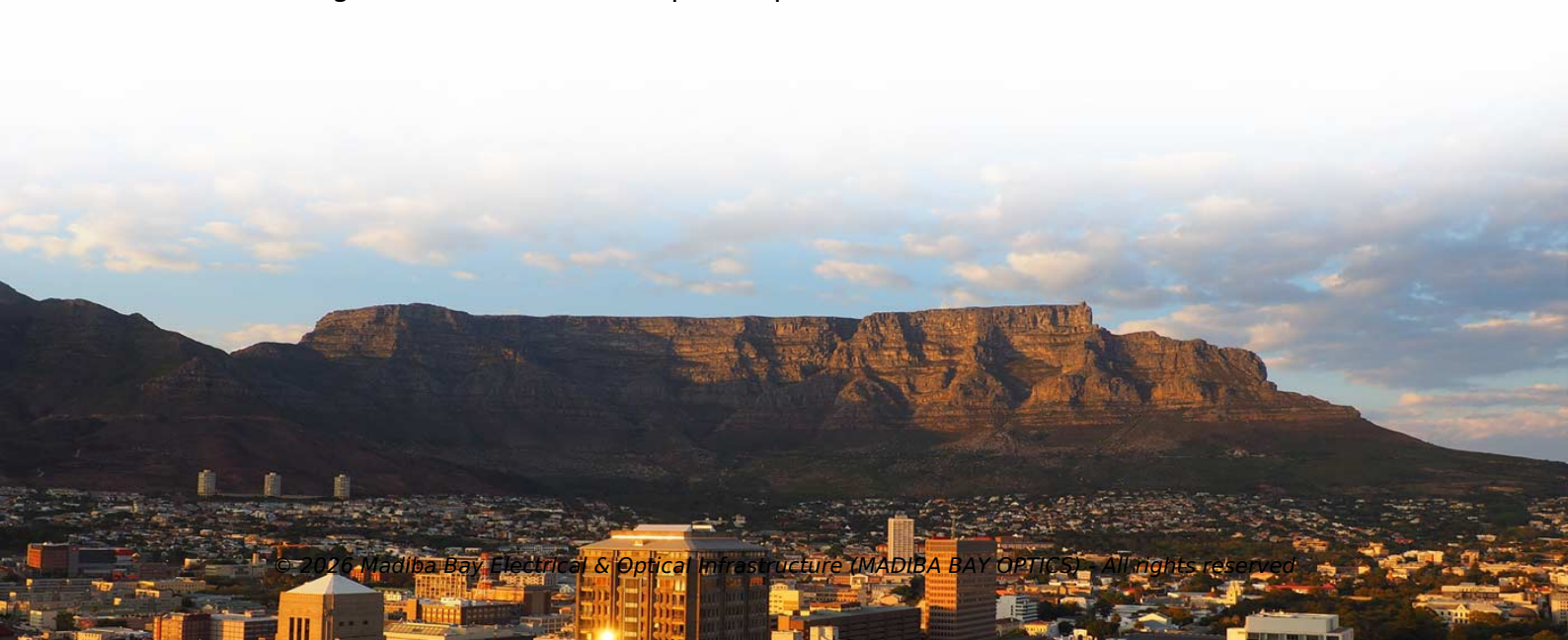


Electrical wave sound from the distribution box



Overview

This low-level hum is caused by the slight vibration of electrical currents or magnetic fields within components like transformers or the main breaker. If the sound is only audible when standing directly next to the panel and remains constant, it is not a cause for immediate concern. A breaker box (electrical panel or service panel) is the main distribution center for your home's electrical system. It routes power from the service entrance and divides it among individual circuits. In this guide, we'll walk through these.
