- Cable Types: Can be simplex (single fiber) or duplex (two fibers) with various sheathing options like PVC, OFNR, OFNP, or LSZH.
- Polishing Options: UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) or APC (Angled Physical Contact) to optimize signal quality and reduce back reflection.
