

Fabrication of power cable trays

Material Selection

The cut pieces are then shaped into strips or panels, which will form the sides, base, and rungs of the tray. Accuracy in this stage ensures proper assembly and structural integrity.

Forming and Roll Forming

Cable trays are shaped into their final profiles using roll forming machines or press brakes. Roll forming machines continuously shape metal coils into ladder-type, perforated, or solid-bottom trays with consistent dimensions and structural strength . Press brakes handle complex bends, flanges, and mounting brackets, allowing integration of elbows, tees, and crosses for directional flexibility.
