- **Splicing Interface:** The bare fiber end of the pigtail is fusion or mechanically spliced to the incoming fiber cable, creating a permanent, low-loss joint .
- **Equipment Connection:** The connectorized end plugs into patch panels, switches, or optical distribution frames (ODFs), enabling easy integration with network devices .
- **Signal Quality Assurance:** Factory-terminated connectors ensure low insertion loss and high return loss, which is difficult to achieve with field-installed connectors .
- **Deployment Efficiency:** Using pigtails reduces installation time and labor costs compared to terminating connectors directly in the field, while improving long-term network reliability .
