This hierarchical design ensures a robust and scalable network capable of supporting building automation, security, and communication systems simultaneously .

Structured Cabling and Network Design

Smart building fiber networks in India follow a structured cabling approach:

- Vertical Conduits: Fiber runs from the main entry point to floor distribution points.
- Modular Splice Systems: Up to 288 fibers converge in the main distribution room, terminated in 1U splice boxes with high packing density .
- Pre-terminated MPO Connectors: Standardized 12 or 24-fiber connectors allow tool-free plug-and-play installation with defined polarities .
