

Fiber Optic Cable Suspension Line Weight

The weight of a fiber optic cable suspension line depends on the type of suspension (single or double), cable diameter, and hardware components, with typical single suspensions ranging from 34 inches to 48 inches in length and designed to support the cable's dead weight without damaging fibers.

Suspension Types and Specifications

Single Suspension:

- Designed for line or elevation angle changes up to 30°
- Compact design, typically 34 inches in length

- Slip load initially 10-20% of standard OPGW rated breaking strength, ensuring safe support of cable weight

Double Suspension:

- Used for line or elevation angle changes from 30° to 60°
- Typically 48 inches in length
- Provides additional support for longer spans or higher tension points
