Bandwidth Characteristics

- **High Bandwidth:** Fiber optic cables can carry significantly more data than traditional copper cables. For instance, they can handle up to 60 terabits per second, which is over 1,000 times more bandwidth than copper cables used for DSL connections .
- **Single-Mode vs. Multi-Mode:**
 - **Single-Mode Fiber:** This type has a smaller core (about 9 microns) and allows light to travel in a single path, resulting in higher bandwidth and longer distances (up to 40 km for 10 Gbps) without significant signal loss .
 - **Multi-Mode Fiber:** With a larger core (50-62.5 microns), this type can carry multiple light signals simultaneously but is more suitable for shorter distances due to modal dispersion .
