Fusion Splice Patch Cords

Fusion splice patch cords are designed to be terminated in the field using a fusion splicer, which permanently joins two fiber ends by melting them together. These cords often come as pre-terminated pigtails, which have one end with a connector and the other end left bare for splicing. This allows technicians to create a seamless connection to a patch panel or optical distribution frame (ODF) while maintaining minimal signal loss.
