Fiber Types

Patch cords are available in single-mode (SM) and multimode (MM) variants. Single-mode fibers (OS1/OS2) are used for long-distance or high-bandwidth applications, while multimode fibers (OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5) are suitable for shorter distances and high-density data center environments. Bend-insensitive fibers (G.657A1/A2) are ideal for tight spaces and FTTH deployments.

Connector Types

Common connectors include LC, SC, ST, MPO/MTP, and APC variants. The choice depends on the equipment interface and network design. MPO connectors are high-density solutions that can house multiple fibers in a single ferrule, supporting 8, 12, 16, 24, or more fibers. MTP® is a branded MPO connector with enhanced performance.

Polarity and Duplex Configuration

Patch cords can be simplex (one-way) or duplex (two-way). Duplex cords often have A/B polarity markings to ensure correct signal flow. MPO systems follow Method A (straight-through), Method B (reversed), or Method C (pairs flipped) to maintain proper channel polarity. Correct polarity planning is critical to avoid link failures.
