The gel fills microscopic gaps, reducing back reflections. Mechanical splicing is faster and simpler, suitable for temporary repairs or budget-limited projects, but it generally results in higher signal loss and is less permanent than fusion splicing .

Preparation and Execution

Proper fiber preparation is crucial for both methods. Steps include:

- **Cleaning:** Use lint-free wipes with 99%+ isopropyl alcohol to remove dust, oil, or residue from fiber ends. For stubborn contaminants, optical-grade cleaning pens or fluids may be used .
