Tungsten electrodes gradually become rounded and pitted, causing arc characteristics to drift, which can result in cold splices or core deformation. Most manufacturers recommend replacement after 1,500–3,000 arcs, with some models like the QBL Fusion Splicer specifying 2,000 arcs. Splice quality degradation, visible bubbles, or increased signal loss are signs that electrodes need replacement sooner.

- **Power Off and Unplug:** Ensure the splicer is completely powered down for safety.
- **Remove Old Electrodes:** Open the electrode cover and carefully unscrew the worn electrodes, noting their original positions.
- **Clean the Splicer:** Remove any debris inside the welding zone to prevent damage to the new electrodes.
- **Install New Electrodes:** Insert the new electrodes securely, ensuring proper alignment and contact.
- **Calibrate the Splicer:** Run an arc calibration to adjust the splicer for optimal performance.
