According to the TIA-598-C standard, individual fibers within a multi-fiber cable are color-coded in a 12-color repeating sequence to simplify identification and reduce errors during installation or maintenance. The first twelve fiber colors are:

- Blue
- Orange
- Green
- Brown
- Slate (Gray)
- White
- Red
- Black
- Yellow
- Violet
- Rose (Pink)
